Operative experience (text for fellowship to enter): The program provides a wealth of neurotologic operative experience at the three major sites for patients of all ages, including extensive surgical training experience in cranial base tumors, vestibular schwannoma, meningioma, facial paralysis, and vestibular dysfunction, concentrating efforts in neurotologic and cranial base procedures.

A special feature of the program includes training in open and endoscopic anterior skull base surgery. Training also encompasses advanced and complicated otology cases, including revision stapes surgery, petrous apex cholesteatoma removal, endolymphatic shunts, intracranial complications of otitis media, and cochlear implantation of children and adults.
